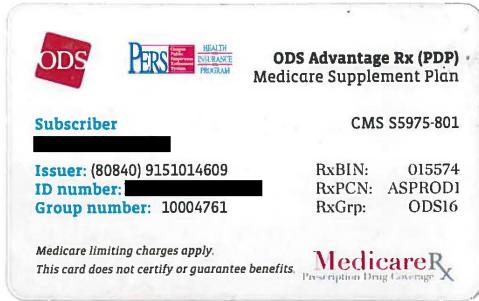


A Guide to Retiree Medical ID Cards

EWEB Tier 1 & Tier 2 Retirees are eligible to receive a variety of benefits which are available to them through separate carriers. This guide is intended to help EWEB retirees navigate the various ID cards they might receive from different carriers.

Medical Plan ID Card

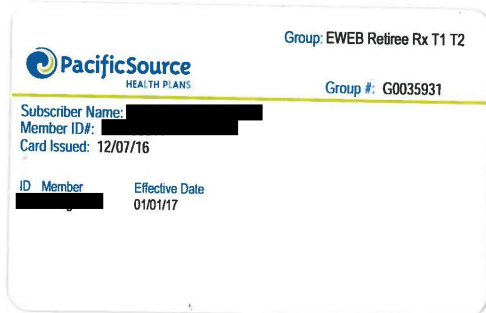


What is this card for? PERS Medicare Plans

When might I use this? At the doctor's office, the ER/Urgent Care, or at the pharmacy.

Anything else I should know? Retirees enrolled in the PERS Health Insurance Program (PHIP) have different carrier options. Your card might look different than this one... instead of ODS it could show Moda, Kaiser, PacificSource, or Providence.

RX Supplemental Plan ID Card



What is this card for? Rx Benefit for Tier 1 & Tier 2 only

When might I use this? When you are getting ready to submit a reimbursement claim for any out of pocket prescription costs, after you have filled an Rx with the card above.

Anything else I should know? Do not use this card at the pharmacy counter. It should only serve as a reference to find your Member ID# when you are submitting a reimbursement claim.

Delta Dental Plan ID Card



What is this card for? Dental Coverage on EWEB Plan

When might I use this? At the dentist's office.

Anything else I should know? You might also be enrolled in a PERS dental plan, so make sure your dentist knows that for filing claims.

VSP Vision Plan ID Card

What is this card for? Vision coverage on EWEB Plan

VSP does not issue ID cards.

You can simply tell your provider that you have coverage through VSP. They will be able to confirm your coverage in their database.
